4 Easy steps to using Wi-Fi in Glasgow Libraries

Step 1

To access Wi-Fi, you need to be a member of Glasgow Libraries. If you're not already a member, please ask the library staff how to join.

Step 2

Your laptop, PDA or mobile phone should have a built-in wireless connection. Windows, Macs and other operating systems are supported.

Step 3

Launch your browser and the Glasgow Libraries portal page will appear.

Step 4

If you've previously registered as a Wi-Fi user with Glasgow Libraries, then simply login with your user name and password. If you've not yet registered, click the 'Register' button and complete the online registration form. The 1st ten characters of your library card act as your user name and you can then select a password. Don't use your library pin number – choose a new password. Following registration, you must login to start using the Internet straight away.
