

Museum Guide

Welcome to the Burrell Collection. On display you will find just a small portion of the more than 8,000 objects that shipping magnate Sir William Burrell donated to Glasgow in 1944. Focusing on late medieval and early Renaissance Europe, the Collection also contains important examples of Chinese and Islamic art, French paintings and objects from Ancient Civilizations.

As you make your way around the Burrell you'll find amazing works by Rembrandt, Degas, Cézanne and the French Impressionists, as well as stunning medieval, Chinese and Islamic collections. Don't miss the 'must-see' objects highlighted in this floor plan, and if you're in a hurry, ask about our 'One Hour Highlights'.



At the Burrell there is always something to do, from hands-on workshops to talks, tours and family-friendly activities. For details, consult the information board in the Courtyard or ask any member of staff. There is a regular programme of changing exhibitions and events, so do pop in and see what is going on.

Make sure you visit the museum shop and take a break in the café. Don't miss the chance to explore Pollok Park, with its beautiful woodland and great outdoor facilities. Pollok House is close by, showcasing the Scottish country house at its best. All of this adds up to a remarkable day out in Europe's best park.

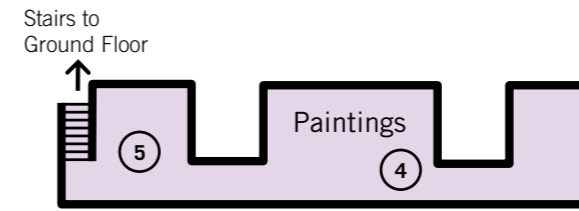

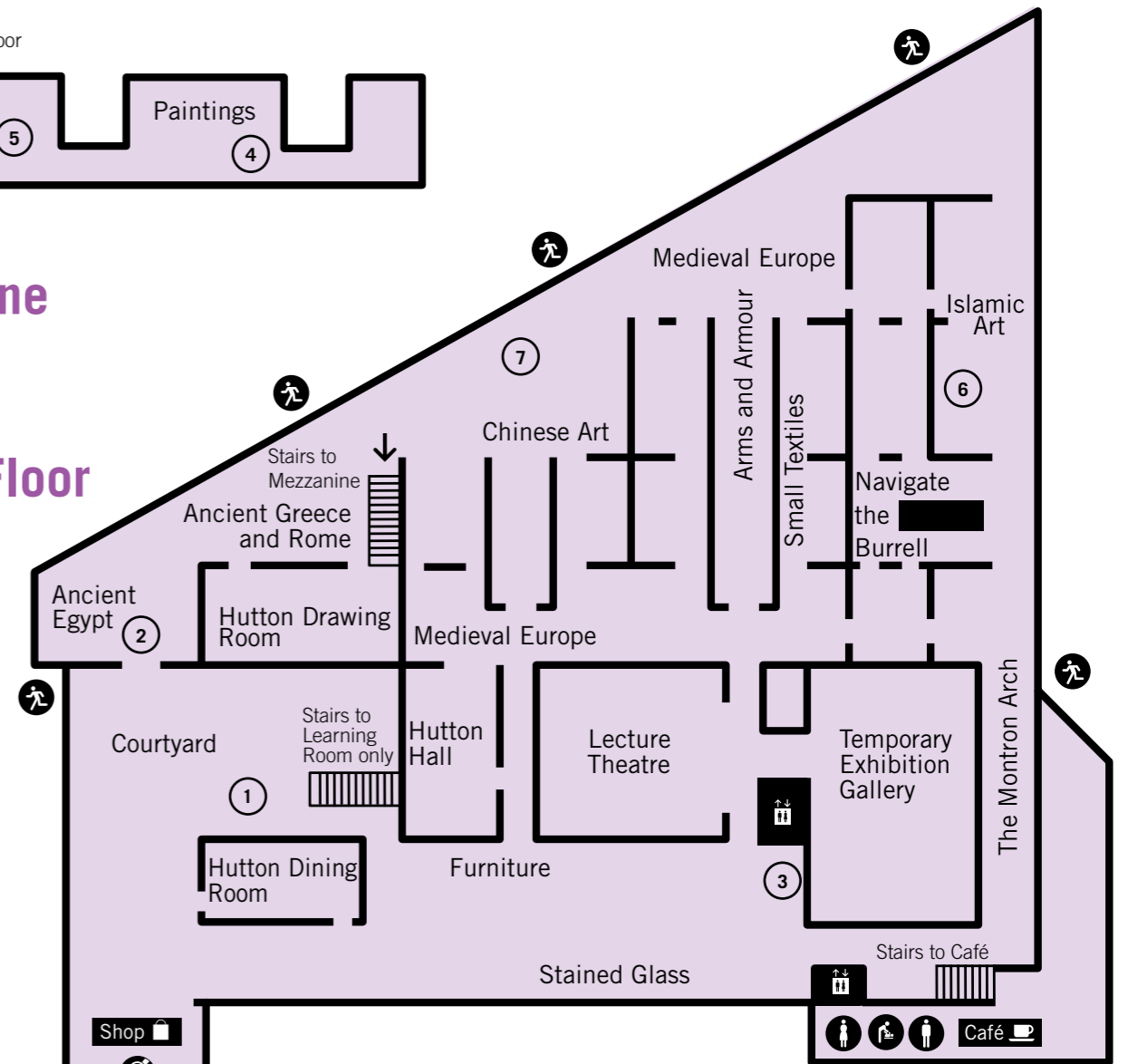

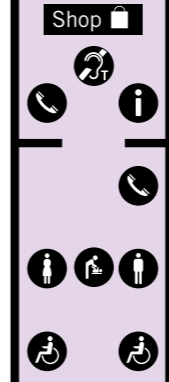
