Welcome to Scotland Street School Museum. The school, designed by Glasgow's most celebrated architect Charles Rennie Mackintosh, is now a museum that tells the story of education in Scotland from 1872 to the late 20th century.

At Scotland Street School you can travel back in time in our three reconstructed classrooms to see what school days were like in the reign of Queen Victoria, during World War II, and in the 1950s and 60s. You can also learn about Mackintosh's designs through the displays and on our touch-screen computers.



And don't miss the 'must-see' objects highlighted on this floor plan.

At Scotland Street School Museum there is always something to do, with a programme of events for young and old. There is also a regular programme of temporary exhibitions. For details, visit the Enquiry Desk in the main foyer or ask one of the staff.

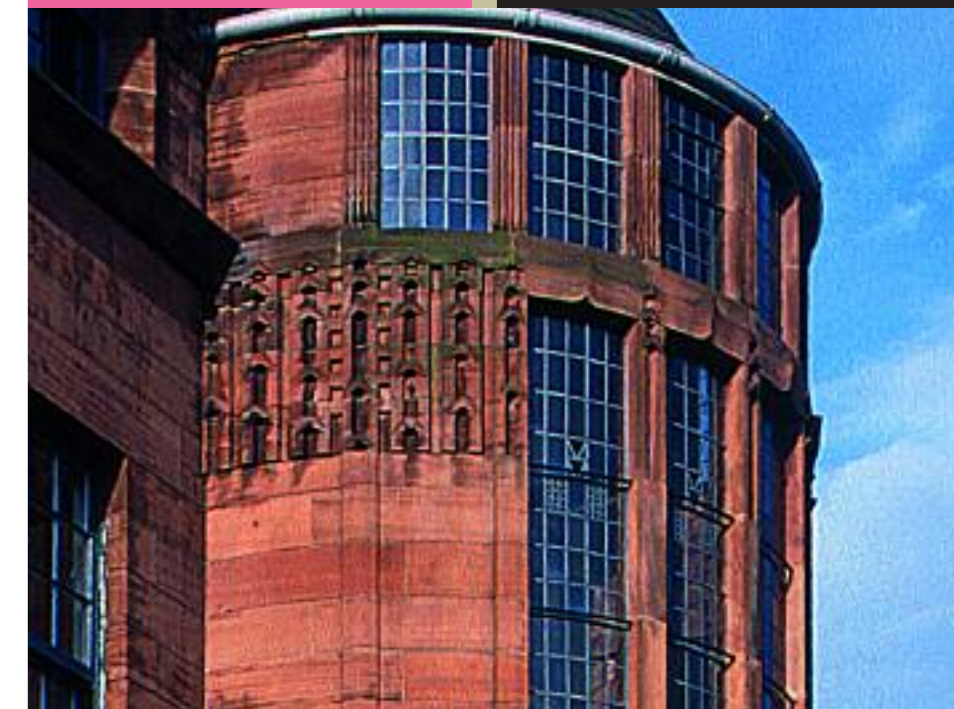

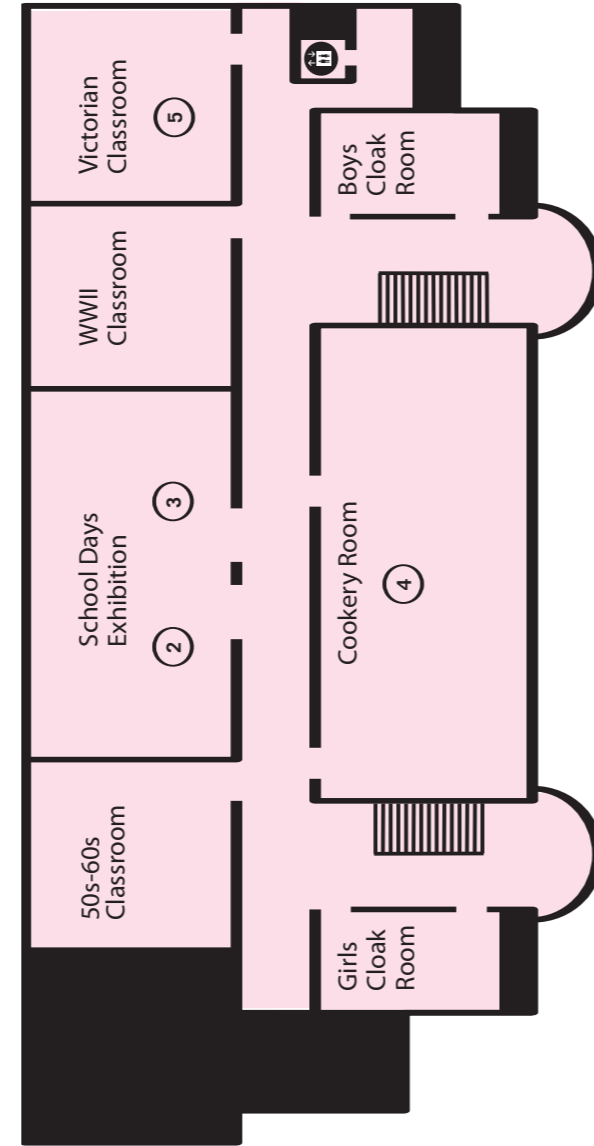

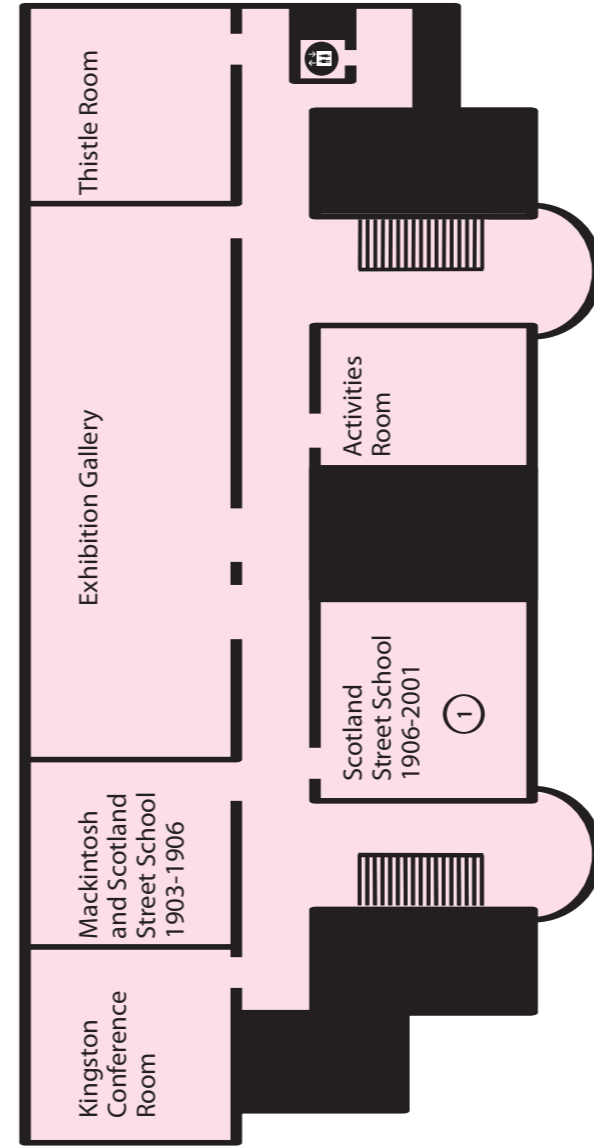
## Gallery Rules
