

Glasgow Ambassador Programme –

- 1. Can I still apply to become a Glasgow Ambassador?**
The Glasgow Ambassadors Programme application process runs until Tuesday 31st January 2012.
- 2. When will I get a response to my Glasgow Ambassador Programme application?**
You will be informed if you have been successful or not in your application by mid-February 2012.
- 3. What happens if I have been successful in my application?**
You will be short listed and asked to attend an informal interview in late February/ March 2012. If successful you will be offered a position within Glasgow Ambassador Programme and invited back for registration and training.
- 4. When will I know if I have been successful in my interview?**
By March 2012.
- 5. I have applied to the Games Maker programme; can I still apply to the Glasgow Ambassador Programme?**
Yes. However, if you are successfully accepted for both schemes, you will not be able to volunteer on the same days due to the time commitments.
- 6. As a person with disabilities, will I be able to volunteer alongside my support worker/personal assistant?**
We are committed to ensuring that everybody has equal access within the Glasgow Ambassador Programme. This means that if you require a reasonable adjustment to carry out your Ambassador role, as a result of your disability, we will make every attempt to accommodate this.
- 7. Will Glasgow Ambassadors be involved in stewarding within the Olympic Venue; Hampden Park?**
No. Glasgow Ambassadors will welcome visitors to Glasgow during the 2012 Olympic Games, and won't be involved in stewarding within the Olympic venues.
- 8. Will you pay for volunteers to get to their location at Games time?**
No. Ambassadors will be expected to get to the location of their shifts during the Olympic Games.
- 9. Will there be training for volunteers?**
Yes. Volunteers will be required to attend two training sessions, in April 2012 prior to the Games, in addition to some self research and reading about the Glasgow Ambassador Programme and your role within it.
- 10. How will the recruitment process ensure that Ambassadors represent the diversity of Glasgow?**
Glasgow Ambassadors will represent the city and we want to recruit a variety of representatives. The Glasgow Ambassador Programme is committed to ensuring that our recruitment is fair and equal to everyone regardless of their background. Equality monitoring will be undertaken on all the applicants and ambassadors appointed to ensure we have a diverse range of ambassadors.
