Sir Chris Hoy Velodrome Rider Code of Conduct

Purpose: To ensure the safety, respect, and enjoyment of all riders and staff, and to promote a positive and inclusive environment at the Sir Chris Hoy velodrome.

1. General Behaviour

- Treat all riders, coaches, officials, staff, and spectators with **respect and courtesy**.
- Abide by the **rules of the track**, including signage and announcements from staff or coaches.

2. Track Etiquette

- No entering or riding on the track without permission Only enter when told to do so.
- Always ride in a **predictable and consistent manner** —Hold your line Do not weave or drift up/down the track unexpectedly.
- **Do not stop on the track** unless in an emergency. Exit the track safely using designated areas.
- Look before you move up or down the track.
- Do not spit or clear your nose on any part of the Velodrome.

3. Safety & Equipment

- Always wear helmets when riding.
- Track bikes must be **fixed gear with no brakes** and in safe working condition.
- Check your bike **before every session**: wheel nuts tightened, inflated tyres, and working drivetrain.
- Do not wear earphones or use mobile devices while on the track.
- For safety reasons, **please remove or cover cycle computers** before riding on the track.

4. Session Conduct

- Arrive on time and sign in. Late arrivals may be refused entry.
- Always follow coaches' instructions.
- In coached sessions, respect the session structure.
- **Ride only when instructed**, failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct may result in removal from the session or further action.

5. Inclusivity & Respect

- Encourage a **supportive and inclusive environment** for all riders, regardless of ability, age, gender, race, or background.
- Bullying, harassment, or exclusion will not be tolerated.
- Report unsafe behaviour or breaches of conduct to a staff member.

6. Photography & Media

- **No photography or filming** on the track without prior permission.
- Consent **must be obtained** before sharing identifiable images of other riders, especially children.
