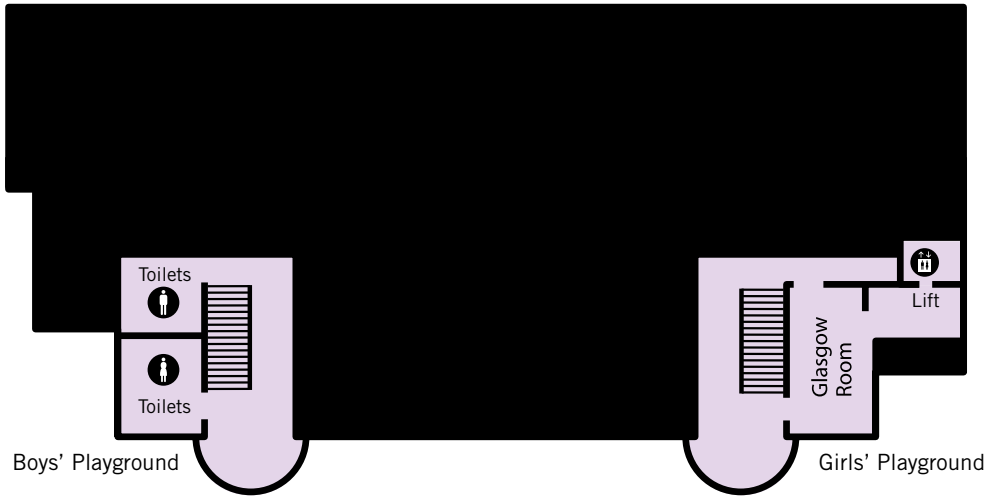
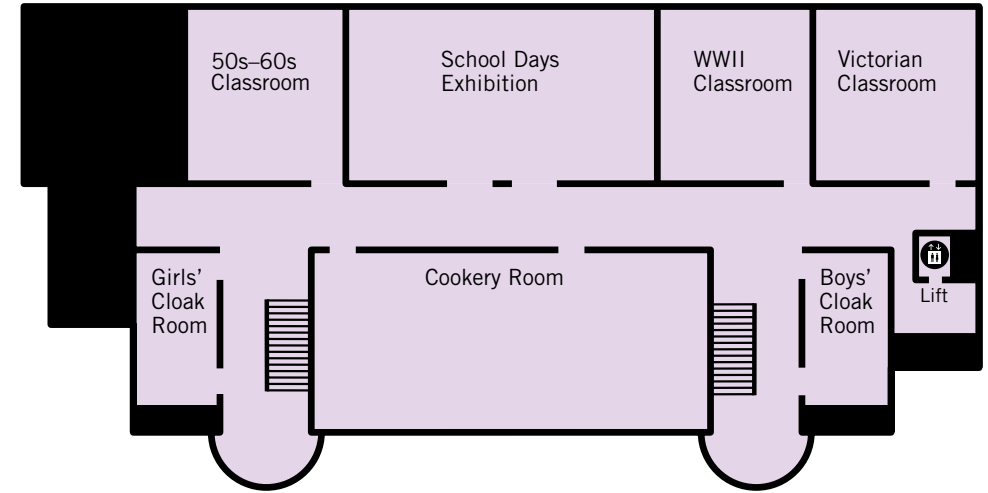


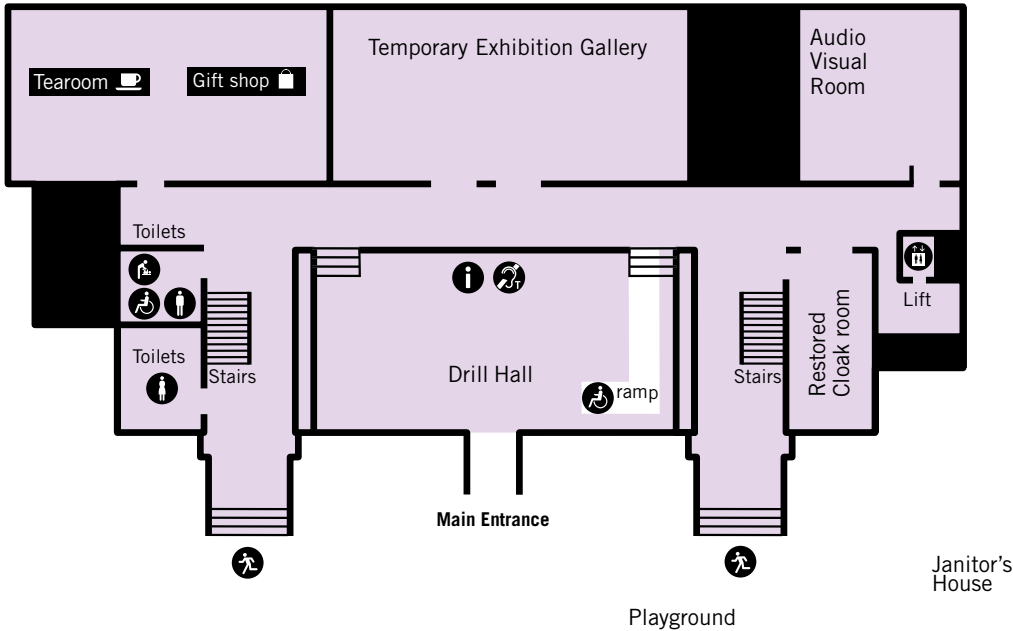
Mezzanine Level



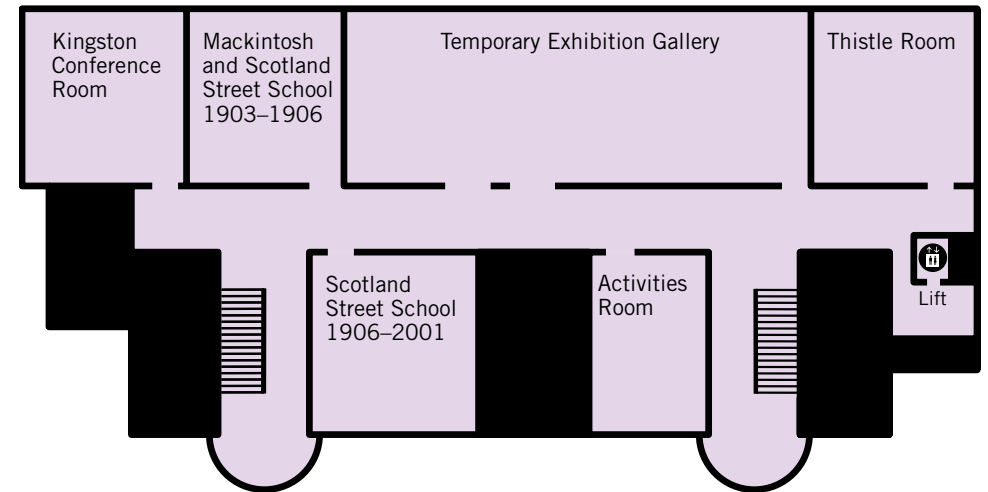
Second Floor

Gallery Rules

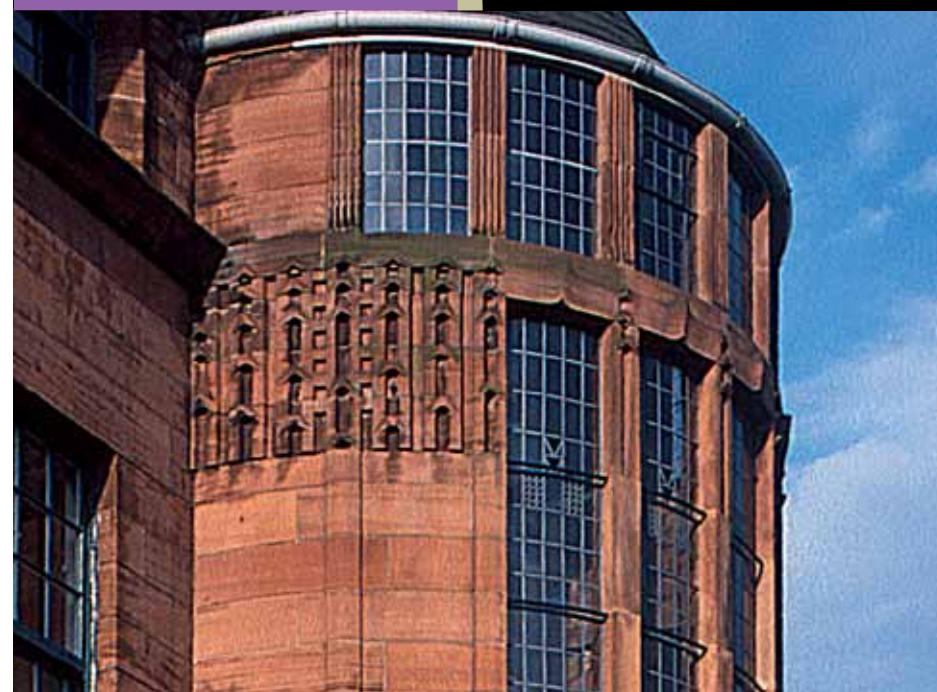
- Please do not touch the objects on display.
