The museum shop is to your left. You can buy gifts here.




Museum staff all wear a purple 'g' logo.

Our computer area is always busy.




There is a Junior section where children can read and draw.

Balcony 1,


and Balcony 2.

You can sit on the bench, watch the video and listen by wearing the headphones.




The create space is at the back of Gallery 2. Children can make art and read books here.

Gallery 4 is upstairs on the second floor. There is art on the walls and art in boxes.




There is a dark cinema space.
