# Air Adhart

Tha Glaschu co-cheangailte ris a' Ghàidhlig 's a cultar ann an dòigh nach gabh fhuasgladh. Tha am baile air an t-slighe a stiùireadh gu tric, gu h-àraidh am measg Ùghdarrasan ionadail taobh a-muigh àiteachan a tha gu h-àbhaisteach aig cridhe a' chàinain, ann an oidhirpean air frèam-obrach làdir a sholarachadh airson Gàidhlig a bhith soirbheachail. Bha Glaschu am measg nan ciad Ùghdarrasan bailteil a leasaich Plana Gàidhlig ann an 2009 agus air moladh mòr fhaighinn airson soirbheachadh nan sgoiltean Gàidhlig.

Tha an Ro-innleachd Ealain Ghàidhlig a leanas air a cruthachadh le Glaschu Beò às leth a' bhaile, agus thèid a lìbhrigeadh leothasan ann an com-pàirteachas le dusanan de bhuidhnean nàiseanta agus ionadail, luchd-ealain agus buidhnean ealain. Tha an ro-innleachd air a deilbh gus na cothroman cruthachail airson Gàidhlig sa bhaile a neartachadh, agus obair den chàileachd ealanta as àirde a chruthachadh a bhios tarraigeach do luchd-amas a tha a' sìor fhàs agus eadar-mheasgte. Tha na h-amasan ro-innleachdail gu h-ìosal glòir-mhiannach agus misneachail agus feumaidh iad a bhith gus àrd-mhiannan leantainneach Ghlaschu airson na Gàidhlig a nochdadu gu soilleir. Tha an cànan, an cultar agus na h-ealain a' saidhbhreachadh beatha a' bhaile agus beatha nan àireamhan de luchd-labhairt na Gàidhlig a tha a' fuireach 's ag obair ann agus a' tadhal air baile Ghlaschu.'

## Àrd-Amas

Is e àrd-amas Ro-innleachd Ealain Ghlaschu Beò na h-Ealain Ghàidhlig a neartachadh ann an Glaschu agus àiteachan eile, agus leis an sin a' meudachadh buaigh agus lèirsinneachd nan ealan ann an co-theacs Ghàidhlig.

Tha Glaschu Beò ag amas air misneachd chultarach Ghàidhlig a' bhaile a mheudachadh le bhith a' tabhann a' chothroim as mothà a ghabhas do shaoranaich Ghlaschu, do bhuidhnean Gàidhlig agus do dhaoine òga airson lìbhrigeadh cultarach Gàidhlig sna bliadhnaichean a tha romhainn. A dh'aindeoin inbhe chugallach na Gàidhlig uaireannan, leanaidh Glaschu Beò air adhart ann an dòigh a tha dàna, a' lorg ghuthan ùra, a' leasachadh mhodailean obrachaидh ùra agus a' toradh obrach den chàileachd as àirde.

# Co-Theacs Ro-Innleachdail

Mar phàirt de Phlana Gàidhlig Comhairle Baile Ghlaschu [2012-17], tha Glaschu Beò a' taisbeanadh Ro-innleachd Ealain Ghàidhlig [2018-22] airson Glaschu.

Thèid a liubhaint le Glaschu Beò ann an com-pàriteachas le measgachadh de bhuidean agus com-pàrtichean ro-innleachdail: Sabhal Mòr Ostaig, a' Cholaiste Ghàidhlig, Conservatoire Rioghail na h-Alba agus Theatar Nàiseanta na h-Alba. Tha an ro-innleachd a' faotainn taic bho Bhòrd na Gàidhlig agus Alba Chruthachail, bhon d' fhuaireadh comhairle ann an leasachadh na ro-innleachd seo.

Bòrd na Gàidhlig

Is e Bòrd na Gàidhlig am prìomh bhuidheann airson Gàidhlig ann an Alba agus 's e a dhleastanas a' Ghàidhlig adhartachadh agus a leasachadh, àireamhan de luchd-labhairt na Gàidhlig àrdachadh agus an raon de chothroman do dhaoine airson an cànan a chleachdad, a mheudachadh. Mar bhuidheann poblach neo-roinneil, chaidh a stèidheachadh fo Achd na Gàidhlig (Alba) 2005 agus shuidhich e susbaint ro-innleachdail do Phrògram agus Ro-innleachd Ealain Ghàidhlig Ghlaschu Beò. Roimhe seo, bha Ro-innleachd Ealain Ghàidhlig Ghlaschu 2011-2014 [air a leudachadh gu 2016] maoinichte tro Mhaoin Buileachaigh Achd na Gàidhlig (GLAIF) air a riaghlaigh le Bòrd na Gàidhlig. Bidh Bòrd na Gàidhlig a' foillseachadh Plana Nàiseanta na Gàidhlig 2018-2022 leis na h-Ealain mar aon de na prìomh stiùirichean airson an cànan agus an cultar a chumail suas san àm ri teachd.

## Co-theacs Nàiseanta do na h-Ealain Ghàidhlig

Is e Alba Chruthachail am buidheann poblach nàiseanta a tha a' cur taic ri ealain, sgrion agus gniomhachasan cruthachail air feadh Alba. Is e Alba Chruthachail cuideachd buidheann maoineachaidh is leasachaidh nan Ealan Ghàidhlig (luchd-ealain agus buidhnean fa leth). Tha e a' maoineachadh àireamh de chompanaidhean Ealain Ghàidhlig mar Bhuidhnean Maoinichte Cunbalach (RFOan), agus a' cur taic ris an roinn tro Mhaoineachadh Phròiseactan Fosgailte agus tro mhaoin tiomnaichte gu Fèisean nan Gaidheal, a' solarachadh meanbh-thabhartasan do luchd-ealain. Tha e ag obair ann an dlùth chom-pàriteachas le Bòrd na Gàidhlig, gu tric a' cothlamadh mhaoinean mar thaic do phìomh phròiseactan is leasachaidhean.

## Co-theacs Ghlaschu don Ghàidhlig

Tha dealas adhartach Ghlaschu Beò a thaobh nan Ealan

Gàidhlig air a mhìneachadh tro Phlana Gàidhlig Comhairle Baile Ghlaschu agus an dàimh obrachail eadar Glaschu Beò agus Comhairle Baile Ghlaschu. Tha an treas Plana Gàidhlig ga leasachadh gu làithreach airson 2018-22 a tha a' co-thaobhadh le Ro-innleachd nan Ealan Ghàidhlig. Anns a' phlana seo, is e an tamas do na h-Ealan Ghàidhlig, ùr-ghnàthachadh, conaltradh agus glòir-mhiann adhartachadh agus a leasachadh anns na h-ealan an taobh a-staigh àrainneachd bhailteil agus àrainneachd sa bheil ionnsachadh chruthachail.

Ann an 2004, rinn Comhairle Baile Ghlaschu inbheisteadh ann an leasachadh Ealan Ghàidhlig ann an co-theacs a baile-mòr ann an Alba. On uair sin tro Ghlaschu Beò, tha e air prògram bailteil Ealan Ghàidhlig a leasachadh a tha gun choimeas ann an Alba. Le 10% de luchd-labhairt na Gàidhlig ann an Alba, agus 11,845 stèidhichte ann am mòr-sgìre Ghlaschu, is e co-chuid cudromach den coimhairsnachd Ghàidhlig làithreach a tha seo.

Cho-dhùin Aithisg Myerscough 2011 gur e Glaschu am baile-mòr as cudromaiche airson cultar san Rioghachd Aonaichte taobh a-muigh Lunnaid. Tha am baile-mòr cultarach co-aimsireil seo fosgailte do lionmhorachd de chothroman airson na h-àireimh de luchd-labhairt na Gàidhlig a mheudachadh agus ùidh anns na h-Ealan Ghàidhlig san fharsaingeachd a leudachadh, tro phrògraman eadar-theachd spreagail de ealain, tachartasan, fèisean, lònraidhean agus iomairean.

Cho-dhùin sgrùdadadh neo-eisimeileach le Deborah Keogh Seirbheis Comhairleachaidh is Comasachaidh (2016) air prògram Ealan Ghàidhlig Ghlaschu Beò, gu bheil àite Ghlaschu Beò cudromach ann an leasachadh agus libhrigeadh tarsainn roinn nan Ealan Ghàidhlig, còmhla ri dleastanas ceannardais agus tagradaireachd. Tha suidheachadh gun choimeas aig prògram Ealan Ghàidhlig Ghlaschu Beò taobh a-staigh co-theacs ùghdarrais ionadail agus a thaobh Buidhnean Nàiseanta airson Gàidhlig.

Tha Glaschu a' leantainn air adhart a' stiùireadh na dùthcha ann am Foghlam tro Mheadhan na Gàidhlig [FMG]. Sa Ghiblean 2016, chaidh an dàrma sgoil tro Mheadhan na Gàidhlig phosgladh agus tha an àireamh de chloinn ann an FMG sa bhaile a-nis còrr air 1000. Tha na h-àireamhan sin a' dol a dh'èirigh le planaichean a bharrachd san amharc airson coimhead ris an tritheamh sgoil. Tha na leasachaidhean üra sin de chudromachd nàiseanta ann an coileanadh nan àireamhan a tha stèidhichte le Bòrd na Gàidhlig. Tha àite cudromach aig Ro-innleachd nan Ealan Ghàidhlig ann an leasachadh choimhairsnachdan agus chothroman airson libhrigeadh cultarach agus com-pàriteachadh do sgoilearan, pàrantan agus a' choimhairsnachd san fharsaingeachd [Coimhead Amas Ro-innleachdail 4]



# Strategic Context

Glasgow Life presents a Gaelic Arts Strategy [2018-22] for Glasgow as part of Glasgow City Council's Gaelic Language Plan [2018-22]

It will be delivered by Glasgow Life in partnership with a variety of agencies and strategic partners. Sabhal Mòr Ostaig, the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland and The National Theatre of Scotland. The strategy is supported by Bòrd na Gàidhlig and Creative Scotland, who were consulted in the development of the strategy.

Bòrd na Gàidhlig

Bòrd na Gàidhlig is the principal body for Gaelic in Scotland and its remit is to promote and develop the Gaelic language, increase the numbers of Gaelic speakers and expand the range of opportunities for people to use the language. As a non-departmental public body, it was established under the Gaelic Language (Scotland) Act 2005 and sets the strategic context for the Glasgow Life Gaelic Arts Strategy. Glasgow's preceding Gaelic Arts Strategy 2011-14 [extended to 2016] was funded through the Gaelic Language Act Implementation Fund (GLIAF) administered through Bòrd na Gàidhlig. Bòrd na Gàidhlig will publish the National Gaelic Language Plan 2018-2022 with the Arts as one of the key drivers to sustain the language and culture in the future.

## National Context for Gaelic Arts

Creative Scotland is the national public body that supports the arts, screen and creative industries across Scotland. Creative Scotland is also the funding and development body for Gaelic Arts (individual artists and organisations). It funds a number of Gaelic Arts companies as Regularly Funded Organisations (RFOs), and supports the sector through Open Project Funding and through a development fund to Fèisean nan Gaidheal providing micro grants to artists. It works in close partnership with Bòrd na Gàidhlig, often combining funds to support key projects and developments.

## Glasgow Context for Gaelic

Glasgow Life's progressive commitment to Gaelic Arts is articulated through Glasgow City Council's Gaelic Language Plan and the operating relationship between Glasgow Life and Glasgow City Council. A third Gaelic language plan is currently being developed for 2018-22 which aligns with the Gaelic Arts Strategy. Within this plan the aim for Gaelic Arts will be to promote and develop Gaelic innovation, engagement and ambition in the arts within an urban and creative learning environment.

In 2004, Glasgow City Council, made an investment into the development of Gaelic Arts in Glasgow. Since then, through Glasgow Life, it has developed an urban based Gaelic Arts programme unique in Scotland. With 10% of Scotland's Gaelic Language speakers, 11,845 based in the Greater Glasgow, this is a significant proportion of the current Gaelic speaking community.

The 2011 Myerscough Report concluded that Glasgow is the most significant city for cultural production in the UK, outside of London. Glasgow as a contemporary cultural city lends itself to a myriad of opportunities for increasing the numbers of Gaelic speakers and broadening interest in Gaelic Arts generally, through dynamic intervention programmes of arts, events, festivals, networks and initiatives.

An independent study by Deborah Keogh Consulting & Facilitation Service (2016), on Glasgow Life's Gaelic Arts programme concluded that Glasgow Life's role in developing and delivering across the Gaelic Arts sector, together with its leadership and advocacy role, is significant. Glasgow Life's Gaelic Arts programme has a unique position within a local authority context and in relation to National Agencies for Gaelic.

Glasgow continues to lead the country in Gaelic Medium Education [GME]. In April 2016 the second Gaelic Medium School opened and the numbers of children in GME in the city is now more than 1000. These numbers are set to rise with further plans for a third school now being looked at. These recent developments are of national significance in achieving target numbers set by Bòrd na Gàidhlig. The Gaelic Arts Strategy has a significant role to play in developing communities and opportunities for cultural expression and participation for pupils, parents and the wider community.

## Buidhnean Com-pàirteachaidh Ghlaschu Beò

Tha obrachadh ann an com-pàirteachas aig teis-meadhain an dà chuid leasachadh agus librigeachd air an ro-innleachd seo. Is iad ar pìomh chom-pàirtichean:

- An Lòchran: buidheann neo-phrothaideach a tha an làthair airson ealain Ghàidhlig adhartachadh an an Glaschu. Tha iad a' sireadh iomhaigh a' chàinain 's a' chultair àrdachadh ann an Glaschu tro thachartasan ciùil agus pròiseactan air an stiùireadh leis a' choimhearsnachd.
- Sabhal Mòr Ostaig [SMO]: ionad Nàiseanta na Gàidhlig agus stiùirichean ann am foghlam Gàidhlig, trèanadh agus rannsachadh, a' tional tomad cudromach de bhuidhnean cultarach co-cheangailte a tha ag adhartachadh Cultar Gàidhlig, Dualchas agus na h-Ealain. Tha SMO agus Glaschu Beò air meòmhreachan còrdaidh aontachadh ann an libhrigeadh ar Ro-innleachd Ealain Ghàidhlig, com-pàirteachas le amas co-roinnt de dh'adhartachadh agus leasachadh air deasbad leantinneach mun cuairt Ealain Ghàidhlig.
- Conservatoire Rioghailean na h-Alba: Is e ionad sàr-mhathais nàiseanta is eadar-nàiseanta a th' ann an Conservatoire Rioghailean na h-Alba airson foghlam ealain gniomhaidh. Suidhichte ann an teis-meadhain Ghlaschu, is e an RCS an t-ionad ealain gniomhaidh as trainge san dùthaich le cùrr air 500 coileanadh poblach a' gabhairt àite gach bliadhna. Ann an 2014, dh'fhoillsich iad ceum MA ann an lonnsachadh is Teagasc Ealain Ghàidhlig.

• Theatar Nàiseanta na h-Alba: Chaidh Theatar Nàiseanta na h-Alba a stèidheachadh ann an 2006, mar an companaidh theatar nàiseanta ann an Alba a bhios a' dol air chuairet a' gniomhadh ann an taighean-cluiche, tallaichean baile, sgoiltean agus làraich a tha sònraichte don chuspair, an dà chuid aig an taigh agus gu h-eadar-nàiseanta agus a' riochdachadh gach iomadh guth a tha san dùthaich. Tha iad dealasach a thaobh in-ghabhail agus riochdachadh air obair le luchd-ealain Ghàidhlig.

- Comhairle nan Leabhrachanean: Is e seo am pìomh bhuidheann le ullach airson a bhith a' cur taic ri ùghdaran agus foillsichearan Gàidhlig agus ag àrdachadh iomhaigh is ruigsinneachd leabhrachanean Gàidhlig ann an Alba agus gu h-eadar-nàiseanta.
- Ceòl's Craic: Is e Ceòl 's Craic am mòr-ionad sòisealta airson cultar Gàidhlig co-aimsireil ann an Glaschu, a' tabhann prògram fad na bliadhna do luchd-èisteachd le Gàidhlig agus gun Ghàidhlig gus deasbad a bhosnachadh air dè th' ann an cultar na Gàidhlig agus cò dha a tha e. Thòisich e a bheatha mar phròiseact air a ruith le Glaschu Beò, ag atharrachadh gu bhith na bhuidheann neo-eisimeileach ann an 2011.

Thar beatha na ro-innleachd seo, bidh sinn ag obair còmhla ri àireamh de bhuidhnean eadar-mheasgta agus buidhnean coimhairsnachd gus liubhairt mu choinneamh ar n-amasan ro-innleachdail.

## Glasgow Life's Partner Organisations

Partnership working is pivotal to both the development and delivery of this strategy. Our key partners are:

- An Lòchran: a non-profit organisation that exists to promote Gaelic arts in Glasgow. They seek to raise the profile of the language and culture in Glasgow through music events and community-led projects.
- Sabhal Mòr Ostaig [SMO]: the National Centre for Gaelic are leaders in Gaelic education, training and research, gathering a critical mass of associated cultural organisations that promote Gaelic Culture, Heritage and the Arts. SMO and Glasgow Life have agreed a memorandum of understanding in delivery of our Gaelic Arts Strategy, a partnership with a shared aim of promoting and developing a progressive debate around Gaelic Arts.
- The Royal Conservatoire of Scotland is a national and international centre of excellence for performing arts education. Located in the heart of Glasgow city centre, RCS is also the nation's busiest performing arts centre with more than 500 public performances taking place each year. In 2014 they launched an MA Learning & Teaching Gaelic Arts.
- The National Theatre of Scotland, established in 2006, is the national theatre company of Scotland which tours work to theatres, village halls, schools and site-specific locations, both at home and internationally and represents the country's many voices. They are committed to the inclusion and presentation of work by Gaelic artists.
- The Gaelic Books Council is the lead literary organization with responsibility for supporting Scottish Gaelic authors and publishers, and for raising the profile and reach of Scottish Gaelic books in Scotland and internationally.
- Ceòl's Craic is the social hub for contemporary Gaelic culture in Glasgow and offers a year round programme for a fluent and non-Gaelic audience, to inspire debate on what Gaelic culture is and who it is for. It started life as a Glasgow Life-run project and became an independent organisation in 2011.

*Over the course of this strategy Glasgow Life will aim to work and collaborate with a diverse group of organisations and community groups to deliver against our strategic aims.*

Chuir Glaschu Beò dàrma Ro-innleachd Ealain Ghàidhlig air bhog air 1ad Giblean 2011 mar phàirt de Phlana Gàidhlig Comhairle Baile Ghlaschu, a' mineachadh prògram glòir-mhiannach airson togail air soirbheachadh na ciad ro-innleachd. Chaith tomad mòr de dh'obair a thoirt gu buil fon ro-innleachd seo, a' foillseachadh tälant ùr, stèidheachadh chom-pàriteachasan ùra agus töiseachadh nithean ùra sna h-Ealain Ghàidhlig. A' leantainn air sgrùdadh neo-eisimeileach le Deborah Keogh, Seirbheis Comhairleachaidh is Comasachaich, is iad lomairtean Leasachaich Tàlaint na pròiseactan as mothu buaidh a chaith a chomharrachadh agus tha a' bhunait Com-pàriteachais làdir is dealasach air a thaisbeanadh tron chruthachadh air measgachadh sònraichte de dh'Ealain Ghàidhlig, a' tabhann tarraing a-steach air luchd-èsteachd ùr.

- Cafaidh Gàidhlig air a stèidheachadh aig *Fèis Bhaile nam Marsantach*.
- *Thaisbean Prògram cultarach Geamannan a' Cho-fhlaitheis Ghlaschu 2014, Fèis 2014*, Gàidhlig airson a' chìad uair ann an co-theacs co-fhlaitheis, le tachartasan Gàidhlig a' tachairt air feadh a' bhaile thar 12 làithean, le cuibheas de thriù tachartasan Gàidhlig gach latha.
- Chaith *Cèiliadh Còmhla*, pròiseact conaltraidh coimhairsnachd, a leasachadh tarsainn choimhairsnachdan sa bhaile ann an ullachadh don Fèis 2014.
- Bha *Fèis 2014* fior chudromach ann an àrd-ùrlaran a sholarachadh airson seòrsaichean ùra de dh'obair Gàidhlig de sgèile, leithid Struileag le Jim Sutherland, Ceòl Mòr Lahore agus Boomerang. Thug luchd-ealaín ris an deach co-chomhairleachadh mar phàirt den ath-sgrùdadh, iomradh air an àm seo mar a bhith deatamach ann am fosgladh chomasan cudromach don Ghàidhlig.
- Chaith *Grounded* le Judy Parrott, taisbeanadh ealaín lèirsinneach bhon Phrògram Ealain Ghàidhlig aig Fèis 2014, air adhart gu bhith air a thaisbeanadh ann an 12 gailearaidhean an Astràilia.

## Gaelic Arts Strategy Successes

Glasgow Life launched a second Gaelic Arts Strategy on 1st April 2011, as part of Glasgow City Council's Gaelic Language Plan, setting out an ambitious programme to build on the success of the first. A huge body of work was produced under this strategy, launching new talent, forging new partnerships and breaking new ground in Gaelic Arts. Following an independent study by Deborah Keogh, Consulting & Facilitation Service the projects identified as having the greatest impact have been the Talent Development Initiatives and the strong, committed Partnership base, demonstrated through the creation of an eclectic mix of Gaelic Arts offers developing new audiences.

Headline successes include:

- *As an Dorchadas*, the site specific theatre piece set in a house in Pollokshields which received critical acclaim [Written by Catriona Lexy Campbell], developed to a full production by Glasgow Life from the original work-in-progress;
- *Macbheatha*, originally a Glasgow Life work-in-progress commission, which went on to play to packed houses at the Citizens Theatre and played as part of the Made in Scotland strand at Edinburgh Festival Fringe [*Performed by David Walker, Directed by Liz Caruthers, Translated by Ian MacDonald*];
- Glasgow Life's Gaelic Arts Performance Programme 2016 x 6. *Buaireas nan Uisge, Uinead, Mus Robh Faclan Ann, Aisling Meadhain Samhraidh, Raon Piobaire, Togail Nàiseanta*. Developed in partnership with The National Theatre of Scotland, Gaelic Books Council and The Royal Conservatoire of Scotland;

- The establishment of a Gaelic Café at the *Merchant City Festival*;
- *The cultural programme for Glasgow 2014 Commonwealth Games, Festival 2014*, presented Gaelic for the first time in a commonwealth context, with Gaelic events taking place across all five areas in the city over 12 days, with an average of three Gaelic events taking place each day;
- *Ceilidh Còmhla*, a community engagement project, developed across communities in the city in the build up to Festival 2014;
- *Festival 2014* was pivotal in providing platforms for new types of Gaelic work of scale, such as *Struileag* by Jim Sutherland, *Ceòl Mòr Lahore* and *Boomerang*. Artists consulted as part of this review referred to this time as critical in opening up significant possibilities for Gaelic;
- A visual arts exhibition from the Gaelic Arts Programme at Festival 2014, *Grounded* by Judy Parrott, went on to be exhibited in 12 galleries in Australia.

## Strategic Aims – Building on Success for Gaelic Arts

Following the recommendations by the Keogh Report [2016], consultation on the Gaelic Arts Strategy through a series of Gaelic Arts Surgeries, and a 12 week collaborative placement at Sabhal Mòr Ostaig, at the Gaelic College in Skye, Glasgow Life confidently presents our 5 key Strategic Aims for our Gaelic Arts Strategy [2018-22].

Each Strategic Aim has an associated key project or programme which will operate on a three year cycle and a multi-partner model. Significant new platforms for these projects will be the Cultural Programme of the European Championship in 2018, The Royal National Mod which comes to Glasgow in 2019 and a legacy programme leading up to 2022.

## Strategic Aim 1:

Introduce and develop a new collaborative working model for Gaelic Arts.

This will be achieved by introducing *Guir*\* – an incubator programme with Gaelic Agencies and Artists from across Scotland.

\*('Guir' is the Gaelic translation of 'incubator')

### Guiding Principles

- A focus on Gaelic voices and stories.
- A new way of working; a space, place, context to experiment, flexibly in form and presentation [e.g. pop-up, non-physical, online, residency].
- Covering a range of art-forms and cross art-form collaborations.
- Identifying new or underdeveloped areas for exploration in Gaelic Arts.
- Exploring Gaelic work which is accessible to Gaelic and non-Gaelic speakers.

### Programmes

Guir is an opportunity to create new and challenging work across agencies and artistic programmes which is flexible and open to all stakeholders to share their practice. It will be based on the devising model of a residency period but will be flexible in form. Each project will be considered within a curatorial context and viewed within a three year cycle. As with all our projects in the strategy our platforms and engagement opportunities will be across the cultural programme of the Glasgow 2018 European Championships, major festivals, community engagement programme , 0-25 year old Mod 2019 and its legacy, and Glasgow as a vibrant and world class city.

## Strategic Aim 2:

Through the Arts, increase opportunities for all to interact with Gaelic by increasing visibility and deepening the awareness of the cultural, linguistic and historical connections Gaelic has with the city.

This will be achieved through *Glaschu Gàidhlig*, an interactive map and engagement and public art programme as a catalyst.

### Guiding Principles

- An interactive map and public art engagement programme.
- A cultural 'overlay' to the city.
- an opportunity for a range of learning outcomes.
- pinpointing where contemporary Gaelic is in Glasgow and challenging popular perceptions of Gaelic in Glasgow.

### Programmes

1. An online interactive tool that will be populated by current research and a collective multi-partner project and resource for residents of, and visitors to, Glasgow, available on personal devices and through festival, library, public and museum platforms.
2. A programme of research and audience engagement, resulting in a series of relevant artistic, cultural and interpretation projects installed across the city and tying in with existing cultural activities to form a Gaelic trail.

## Strategic Aim 3:

Invest in the creative future of the language by facilitating new dialogue, discussion and debate around Gaelic Arts. This will be achieved by co-ordinating a public facing annual *Cultural Symposium* examining the principles of Gaelic Arts and sharing new practice and thinking.

### Guiding Principle

- Encourage new artistic voices in the Gaelic Arts sector within an urban context.
- Debate, share and bring a diversity of practitioners together to examine current thought and practices on Gaelic Arts in Scotland.
- Create a platform for artists, practitioners, creative producers and provocateurs to present new ideas.
- Stimulate debate about the role Gaelic Arts has in the revival and acquisition of the language.

Glasgow Life recognises there has historically been a strategic neglect of Gaelic and its status as a minority language, and that Gaelic Arts has a leading role in how the future of Gaelic can be revitalised as a living, relevant language. The Gaelic Arts Strategy [2018-22] will continue to subscribe to the view of David Crystal, leading authority on world language, that a language's death cannot be halted unless artists take the language seriously.

### Glasgow Context

The city has a critical mass of Gaelic writers, actors, musicians and organisations with a Gaelic remit which makes Glasgow well situated to host this event. These include the National Theatre of Scotland, Playwright Studios, Gaelic Books Council, Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, An Lòchran, Theatre Gu Leòr and MG ALBA. Further to this, Glasgow is also home to 41% of Scotland's actors, dancers, broadcasters, 38% of its musicians and 29% of its artists and graphic designers (Glasgow Cultural Statistics Digest, 2010).

Glasgow Life is responsible for curating and producing creative and cultural programmes, festivals, community tours, venue-based programmes and learning programmes across a range of art forms. Festivals include Celtic Connections, Glasgow International Festival of Visual Arts (GI), Tramway's Unlimited Festival, Dance International Glasgow, Aye Write! Glasgow's Book Festival, the Merchant City Festival and the Glasgow Mela. We manage, develop and deliver UNESCO City of Music, Tramway's performance, visual arts and public engagement programmes, Gaelic Arts, community touring, Glasgow's Poet Laureate and Revitalise (in collaboration with NHS), and provide support for the independent arts sector in Glasgow through leadership, advocacy, grant-giving, and professional development.

### Partnership

With Sabhal Mòr Ostaig we will address this by promoting discussion around the principles, critical thinking and aesthetic of Gaelic Arts for the wider benefit of the national Gaelic Arts and Language sector. With contributions from National Theatre of Scotland, Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, An Lòchran, the University of Glasgow, Tobar an Dualchais and others. The Glasgow Life team will curate and co-ordinate the symposium with the assistance of a curatorial group and production company.

## Strategic Aim 4:

Deliver, develop and support a comprehensive Gaelic Arts offer for young Gaelic speakers between the ages of 0-25 years in Glasgow

### Guiding Principles:

Gaelic Arts has a role to play in increasing curiosity, knowledge and cultural connection that should be engendered within Gaelic Culture as part of the young Gaelic speaker's broader education. Therefore our programme with city wide partners, like An Lòchran, Fèis Ghàidhlig Glaschu, Comman Na Parant and the Saturday Morning Family Group, is aimed at encouraging and building the cultural confidence of young people and their parents.

The programme aims to develop a creative range of extra-curricular activity to promote greater usage of the language and improve levels of Gaelic fluency amongst school pupils whilst working with Sgoil Ghàidhlig Ghlaschu and Bunsgoil Ghàidhlig Ghleann Dail to promote awareness, visibility and engagement.

### Programme

Glasgow Life has a youth strand through our major festivals: Merchant City Festival, Celtic Connections, Tramway, Aye Write! and Glasgow Mela. Our strategy aims to stimulate the Gaelic programme for our young people in that context

### Projects

**Staing/Stance** Glasgow Life will oversee a pilot youth project [age 16-25] in preparation for the Year of Children & Young People in 2018, the Cultural Programme of the European Championships and the Royal National MOD 2019 Over the next three years we hope to develop Gaelic speaking ambassadors and tour guides for these platforms , developing skills and learning for young people.

**Tramway Family Day** This seasonal event supports new audiences to access contemporary arts, maximising the level of engagement and quality of experience for non-specialist existing audiences. Free and open-access, Tramway Family Days target children and their carers, with audiences able to experience a variety of performances and participatory activity as well as current exhibitions in a relaxed and family-friendly environment. We will initiate and build on a Gaelic focused programming strand at this event in the lead up to the MOD 2019 and beyond.

A traditional annual Fèis with a supported programme offering a full range of Gaelic Arts including music tuition, drama, dance, song, arts and sports

## GLASGOW INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF VISUAL ARTS (GI)

Glasgow International is a world-renowned biennial festival of contemporary art. Glasgow International showcases the best of local and international art for wide-ranging audiences. The next edition will happen in the city in April 2018. The festival will continue to showcase Glasgow as a unique major centre for the production and display of contemporary visual art. As well as being one of the largest platforms within Glasgow Life for Gaelic artists and events, over the duration of the Gaelic Arts Strategy Celtic Connections will contribute to the delivery of the 5 strategic aims of the strategy, further increasing the visibility and status of Gaelic within the festival and Glasgow.
