The aim of this guide is to support children, young people and adults with autism to access the venue and the services it offers.

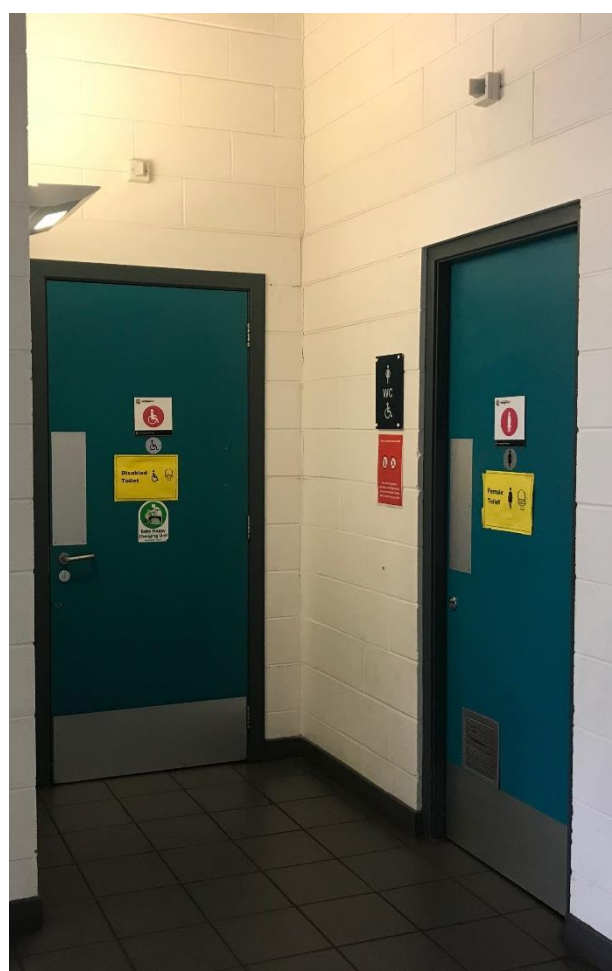
Welcome to Molendinar Community Centre



Once you walk through the front door you will find the information desk.



There are toilets that can be used when at the Community Centre and could be used by anyone visiting. These are across from the information desk.



Staff will wear badges and uniforms like this and will be able to help you.



Sometimes there might not be a member of staff at the desk but if help is needed, someone will come to help as soon as they can.

This is the quiet area. This can be found at the corridor next to the information desk. On the door it will say Meeting Room.



We also have a gym you can use. You will need to be shown how to use it with an induction first. Ask the staff to help before using it.



Cranhill Community Centre can be busy every evening between 5pm and 9pm.

The fire alarm will be tested on a Monday between 9am and 10am.

There is a café that can sometimes be busy and noisy. You might also smell some food. You can buy things to eat and drink.

Computers are available for use at the Community Centre. The staff will help to set up a password.
