Scottish Identity in Art

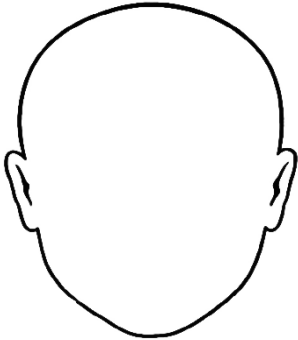


Look opposite the entrance to this gallery, overlooking the balcony and the heads. You will find a sculpture of a famous Scottish poet called **Robert Burns**.

Continue walking until you get close to the floating heads by Sophie Cave. What expressions can you see? Can you draw a different emotion?

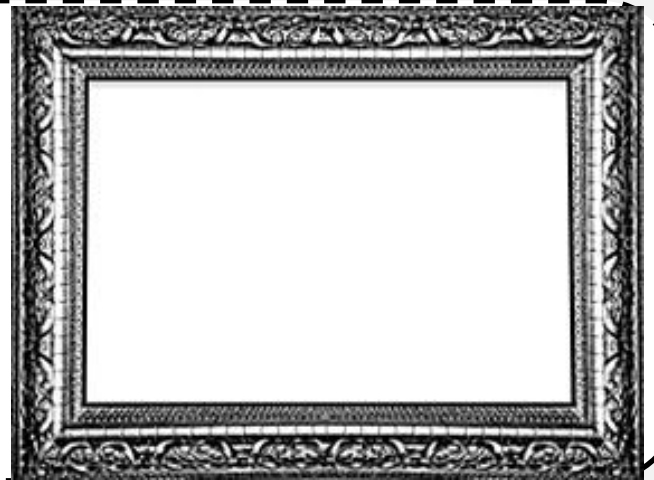
French Art



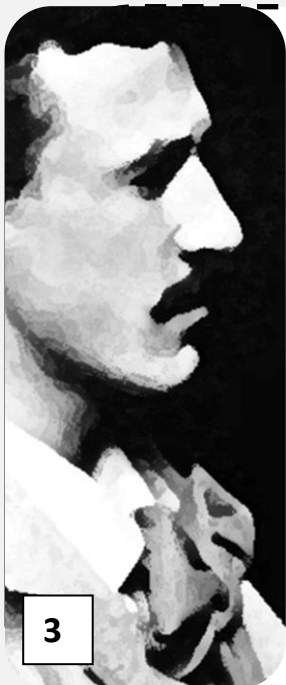
Continue to end of the corridor and enter the gallery called **French Art**.

Charles Rennie Mackintosh is famous for his **architecture and furniture** designs.



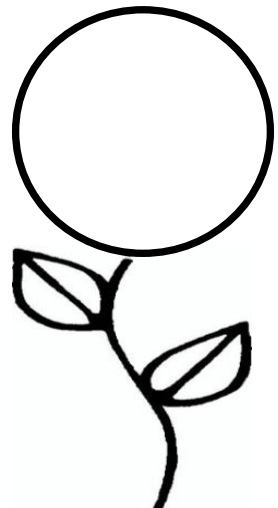
