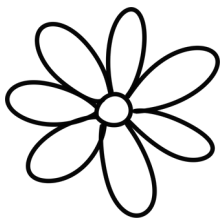

# Day of the Dead Animal Hunt

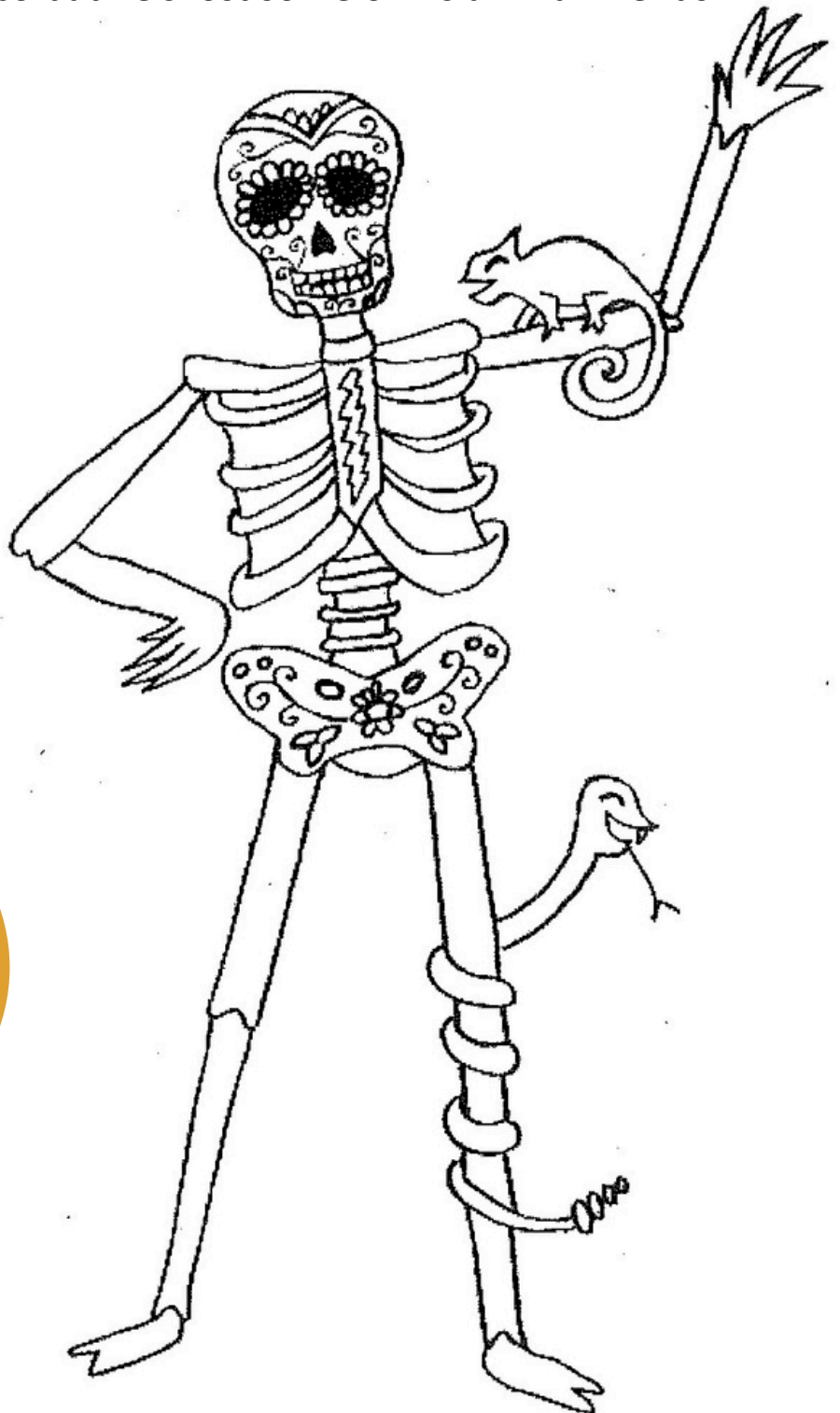


This Skeleton is going to the Day of the Dead Festival in Mexico but he's lost some of his animal friends.

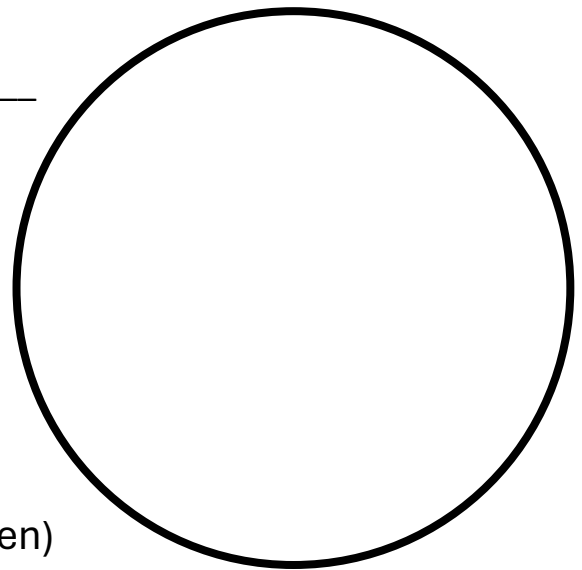

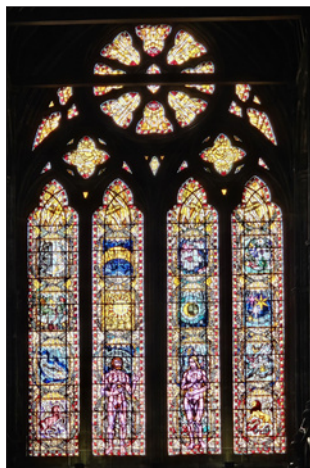
