On entering the library you will find the information desk.








Sometimes there might not be a member of staff at the desk but if help is needed, someone will come to help as soon as they can.

This is the quiet area. This can be found to the right of the library beside the reception desk.










There are also a toilet that can be used when at the library and can be used by anyone visiting.
