## Club Governance Advice

- Obey Government and Public Health restrictions which are highlighted in the easing of lockdown phases, speak to your NGB or local Sport Development Officer if you are unsure of which phase affects you.
- Check club / organisation insurance for government ordered shut down coverage and how this may affect the club / organisation.
- Whilst working / delivering activities virtually ensure that the club / organisation Data Protection policy allows a coach to deliver activity with appropriate security measures. Consider what might need to be put in place to safely allow activities to be delivered online.
- Review governance documents, such as constitutions to determine if club / organisation business such as meetings and resolutions can be completed online.
- Be aware of safeguarding online in relation to club / organisation social media policy, NGB social media policy and restrictions associated to social media and video conferencing platforms
