



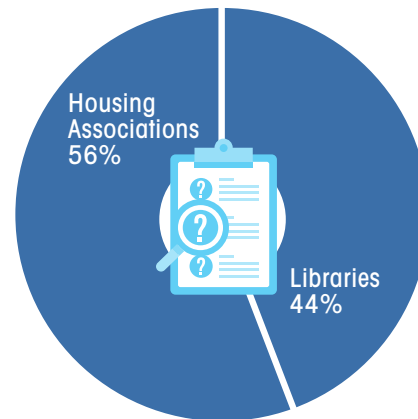
ELDER PARK COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Survey Results Summary

To inform the planning for the future of the new and upgraded Elder Park Library and Community Hub a community engagement process was undertaken to capture the views of the local community.

The survey was live between 2nd - 15th November 2020 and was distributed via Glasgow Libraries and directly to tenants from Elderpark, Linthouse and Govan Housing Associations.

Of those completing the survey, 91% were responding as individuals with the remaining 9% responding on behalf of other organisations from the public, private and third sectors

said that they currently used Elder Park library or another Glasgow Library

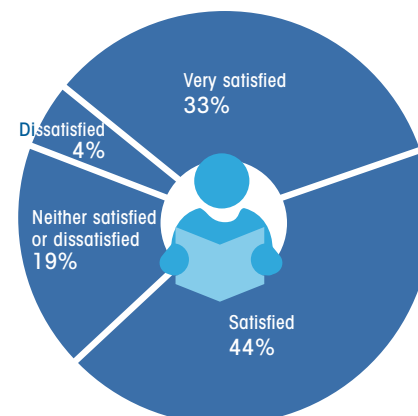

How satisfied are you with current library service at Elder Park or the library you use?

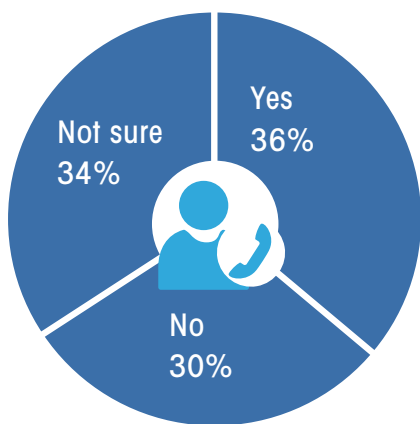


44% Satisfied

COMMUNITY SPACE

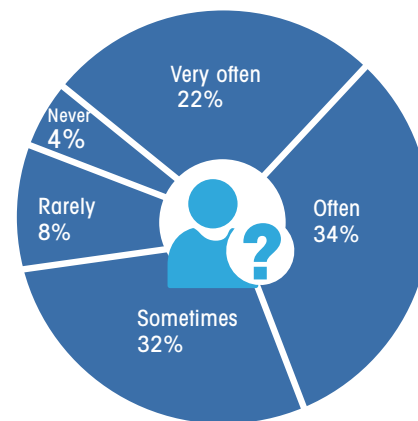
If there was community space available for booking, would you be likely to book it?
