Ceann Creige supported 40 children in the east end of Glasgow to **Get Into Summer** by delivering a free hurling camp in partnership with Conradh na Gaeilge Glaschu. The club received **£1,000** from the fund which also allowed them to provide healthy snacks to all of the children attending and to purchase some equipment for the camp which will continue to be used by the club.
