

CONTINUOUS LINE DRAWING

All you need is paper and a single drawing material of your choice.

You will use one single unbroken line to create your drawing. This means your pen will move across the page without leaving the surface.

As you move across the page you will create additional lines. You can define these from your object lines if you wish by using lighter pressure on the pen as you move.

Continuous line drawing helps develop confidence and drawing speed and improves hand and eye coordination.
