## CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS AT CATHEDRAL PRECINCT

Glasgow Cathedral will this year provide a historic backdrop for our classic Christmas display. Both our Christmas Tree and our famous nativity scene, The Crib, will be on show in Cathedral Square from November 20.

The tree comes from a local supplier, stands 35 feet tall and holds up to 200 shiny Christmas baubles. Cathedral Square is the perfect setting for The Crib, a marvellous steel sculpture that captures the biblical story of the birth of Jesus and the true spirit of Christmas. Designed in the 1990s and fabricated in Govan, The Crib weighs an incredible 2.5 tonnes.

### WINTER WONDERLAND AT ST ENOCH SQUARE

Come see the world's first solar-powered Observation Wheel! Take a ride and see Glasgow from high above. Enjoy fun rides like the magical carousel, visit the Festive Bar with live music, shop for special gifts, and try tasty food and drinks.
